
SCSI QIC 1/4" Tape Drive Emulator to PCMCIA/ CF

Description

The CFtoSCSI SCSI Bridge allows Compact Flash Cards of up to 16GBytes to be attached to a regular SCSI bus. It will be seen as a SCSI QIC 1/4" tape drive by the host computer. The SCSI Tape Bridge can emulate many other SCSI QIC 1/4" tape drive Emulators and can be programmed to suit the host systems requirement.





Features

- Small format PCB converts Compact Flash Media to appear as a SCSI QIC 1/4" Tape Drive on the Host's SCSI bus
- · 3.5" form factor PCB which will replace any 3.5" or 5 1/4" SCSI QIC 1/4" Tape Drive
- Will fit in a 3.5" disk slot using the same mountings
- SCSI Host will typically see the device as a SCSI QIC 1/4" Tape Drive of any emulation
- Board is low power, using 5V only, and has an optional add-on display and pushbutton user interface
- · Microcode is field upgradable via integral serial port
- Optional integration support available if required
